Westhorpe PC have their meetings on the 2nd Tuesday of each month. Would having the meeting out of the village have an affect on public attendance?
- 10. To discuss and approve a plaque for the new slide. Thanking Tesco and the people who took part in the scheme to enable the grant to be awarded.
- 11. To discuss if there should be a notice on the Green stating how to treat the equipment. An email has been received around how some individuals are treating the play equipment and not in the manner it's intended. Like other play areas in other villages, should a Do and Don't notice be produced and placed by the play equipment.
- 12. To discuss and approve replacing the Finningham signs that are no longer in place along the roadside. To order 2 x FINNINGHAM signs for Walsham Road and Wickham Road, totally £230.62 + VAT
- **13.** To discuss what the Council does next with regards to the junction at the White Horse. To get better signage and the white lines re-done, as suggested by Cllr Roy Barker and Cllr Jane Storey. Is there anything else?
- 14. To discuss and approve installing a dog bin at Rob Hall corner. Someone has requested a dog bin near Rob Hall corner. The village already have 9 dog bins and it doesn't seem viable to just move 1 of those bins, having discussed and investigated that during the last meeting. The cost of a dog bin being emptied is £41 a year. Pricing for a dog bin starts from £86.52 + VAT.
- **15.** Welcome packs. Mrs. Sewell confirmed in the January meeting that she has the welcome packs and they are ready to hand out. Have any of the councillors asked Mrs. Sewell for a welcome pack to give to any new residents? It's believed there are quite a few new people to the village and it's not known whether they have received a welcome pack.
- **16.** To discuss the installation of the slide and the next steps. The slide has been installed, but it isn't central within the area and the installer wrongly advised to change the position of the way the slide faces. The Chairman has been speaking to Wicksteed about this.

17. Correspondence Received

- a. An email has been received regarding the removal of the hedging on the site between Gosford House and Highfields.
- b. An email has been received regarding the installation of the new slide and the ongoing issue with anti-social behaviour on the Green and the treatment of the equipment on the Green.
- c. The question has been asked, why is the polling station no longer in the village and is now at Westhorpe village hall. The clerk is waiting for an answer from the electoral team.
- d. It seems finally there is ultrafast broadband along Walsham Road, but only currently through BT.
