It was recommended during the internal audit to amend the reserves policy to include an amount that is for play equipment or the amount of grants received but unspent at the year end. Also, to increase the election cost. Currently policy states £1000 (for election costs) but that cost is £1,300.
- 12. To discuss and approve the next play equipment purchases. Option 1 scramble net, log run and basketball goal = £4,108.85 + VAT or Option $2 \text{horizontal monkey bars, log run and basketball goal = £2,740.70 + VAT.$
